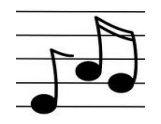

THE COCKMAN FAMILY

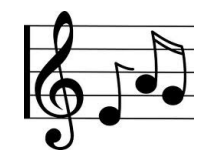

A Tribute to Earth, Wind and Fire

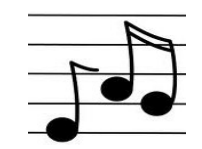

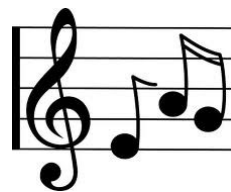
THANK YOU!

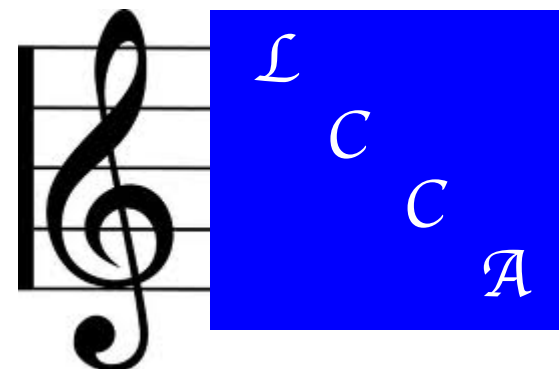
